

## Military Outreach - Outdoor Packing!

Saturday, July 25, noon-2pm, packing with no wait, no lines, as a family, waiting in your car!  
Please remember your mask, there will be sanitizer at each table.

We wish to remember our troops as they keep us safe from year to year. The pandemic does not stop our troops from being deployed.

Here is how it works:

Look for items you would like to share from our list

- Text 424.383.0284 to get in a queue.
- Leave your text and name. The idea is to make a card for your troop member ahead of time to leave on the top of your box. You can make them in your car.
- You and your family or friends in your car will first text me.  
Then, bringing your masks and your cards, park your car on Ellingwood up the hill, or near Mindora.
- The packing is on the corner of Milne and Ellinwood. Text my number that you have arrived and how many people in your car need boxes.
- If you have brought items, let us know and we will take them to the driveway that has tables with items on them as soon as you arrive (driveway is on the corner of Ellinwood and Milne Drive.)
- When you are told it is your turn, bring your cards and you will receive an empty box for each person. You and your people in the car will be the only ones packing at the table - with masks and social distancing.
- When you are finished, you bring your box to the next driveway (you will see filled boxes stacked there).
- Drop your boxes off, pick up a flag, and cross the street. Then return to your car! There will be sanitizing at each table
- It will be a little lonely, but you will be able to pack safely.
- If you want to help, but not pack, please bring items to 5008 Milne Drive and leave them on the red bench any day before or after July 25). Checks are welcome, if you do not want to shop.
- We are hoping to get as many Keurig pods as we can (they come in boxes) as this squadron has a Keurig machine! But the list has other items needed as well. You choose!!
- Thank you for continuing to support our military outreach as we have always done in the past.

- Pick whichever way you wish to help, and you will be a hero because you still remember our deployed military even through this Pandemic!
