
## **OPENING ACCLAMATION**

LEADER God the Father, your will for all people is health and salvation;

**PEOPLE** We praise you and thank you, O Lord.

LEADER God the Son, you came that we might have life, and might have it more abundantly;

**PEOPLE** We praise you and thank you, O Lord.

LEADER God the Holy Spirit, you make our bodies the temple of your presence;

**PEOPLE** We praise you and thank you, O Lord.

LEADER Holy Trinity, one God, in you we live and move and have our being;

**PEOPLE** We praise you and thank you, O Lord.

LEADER Lord, grant your healing grace to all who are sick, injured, or disabled, and all who are suffering from the coronavirus, that they may be made whole;

**PEOPLE** Hear us, O Lord of life.

LEADER Grant to all who seek your guidance, and to all who are lonely, anxious, or despondent, a knowledge of your will and an awareness of your presence;

**PEOPLE** Hear us, O Lord of life.

LEADER Mend broken relationships, and restore those in emotional distress to soundness of mind and serenity of spirit;

**PEOPLE** Hear us, O Lord of life.

LEADER Bless physicians, nurses, and all others who minister to the suffering, granting them wisdom and skill, sympathy and patience;

**PEOPLE** Hear us, O Lord of life.

LEADER Grant to the dying peace and a holy death, and uphold by the grace and consolation of your Holy Spirit those who are bereaved;

**PEOPLE** Hear us, O Lord of life.

LEADER Restore to wholeness whatever is broken by unforgiveness and human sin, the failure to love, in our lives, in our nation, and in the world;

**PEOPLE** Hear us, O Lord of life.

LEADER You are the Lord who does wonders:

**PEOPLE** You have declared your power among the peoples.

LEADER With you, O Lord, is the well of life:

**PEOPLE** And in your light we see light.

LEADER Hear us, O Lord of life:

**PEOPLE** Heal us, and make us whole.

LEADER We pray for those killed or injured in acts of terrorism, injustice, gun violence, abuse or prejudice of any kind, and from the consequences of diseases and natural disasters. We pray for the healing of those suffering from the coronavirus and those ministering to them.


Jesus Christ, the Wounded Healer, has overcome all that can threaten us.
