LEADER Lord, grant your healing grace to all who are sick, injured, or disabled,
that they may be made whole;

PEOPLE Hear us, O Lord of life.

LEADER Grant to all who seek your guidance, and to all who are lonely, anxious, or despondent,
a knowledge of your will and an awareness of your presence;

PEOPLE Hear us, O Lord of life.

LEADER Mend broken relationships, and restore those in emotional distress to soundness of mind
and serenity of spirit;

PEOPLE Hear us, O Lord of life.

LEADER Bless physicians, nurses, and all others who minister to the suffering, granting them wisdom
and skill, sympathy and patience;

PEOPLE Hear us, O Lord of life.

LEADER Grant to the dying peace and a holy death, and uphold by the grace and consolation of your
Holy Spirit those who are bereaved;

PEOPLE Hear us, O Lord of life.

LEADER Restore to wholeness whatever is broken by unforgiveness and human sin, the failure to love,
in our lives, in our nation, and in the world;

PEOPLE Hear us, O Lord of life.

LEADER You are the Lord who does wonders:

PEOPLE You have declared your power among the peoples.

LEADER With you, O Lord, is the well of life:

PEOPLE And in your light we see light.

LEADER Hear us, O Lord of life:

PEOPLE Heal us, and make us whole.

LEADER Please join us in saying the Lord's Prayer.

ALL Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy Name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever and ever. Amen.
